

Competitions Committee Executive Regulations

(These Regulations are set to organize all type of Competitions and Tournaments approved by the International *Tent Pegging* Federation).

Article (1): Competition Committee Formation and Meetings

- The Committee is formed by the decision of the Board of Directors who must recognized experience in the *Tent Pegging Sport* and adequate efficiency in the organization and management of the Sport Competitions and Tournaments.
- The Committee shall convene once a year periodically or whenever required thereby. It is considered in a continuous meeting during International Competitions and Tournaments.
- The attendance of two thirds of the Committee Members (including the Chairman) is requisite to hold bona fide meetings, whether periodical or emergency.
- The majority of votes on a decision shall be considered. In case of equal votes, the vote of the Committee's Chairman tilts the scale.
- The Committee shall elect one of its members as Secretary who shall take down the minutes of the meetings in a special record. The member Local Federations shall according to their specialization, be notified of the decisions of the Committee, having been endorsed by the Board of Directors of the International *Tent Pegging* Federation.

Article (2) Competitions Committee Tasks and Responsibilities

The Committee shall be tasked with the following:

- Prepare, manage, and organize the International Tournaments approved by the Board of Directors of the International *Tent Pegging* Federation.
- Bring about any procedures or introduce any amendments deemed appropriate to make the competitions and tournaments successful, subject to approval of the Board of Directors of the International *Tent Pegging* Federation.
- Design a model of all matters related to the process of organizing an International Tournament in a Member State, including the following:

Place of the Tournament

Type of Soil

Length of the Racetrack, whether open or closed

Type of Pegs

Toilets and their availability

If for any reasons a Tournament cannot be held as scheduled, it shall be postponed for one week unless the Committee decides to fix another date accordingly. However, the postponement decision has to be approved by the Board of Directors of the International Federation before notification of the Local Federations.

Article (4) Cancellation of the Competitions

Any Competition whereas not less than three Local Federations are participating, shall be cancelled. The Competitions Committee is required to notify the Board of Directors of the International Federation and the organizing Local Federation of such cancellation and the reasons thereto.

Article (5) Complaints

Only the Manager of the Team participating in the Tournament may raise a complaint with regard to the result of any competition in which one of his players is taking part. Such complaint must be official and made on the relevant format during at least a period of 30 minutes after the end of the game under dispute.

The Complaint is to be submitted to the International Tournament Supervisory Committee.

A Complaint Fee of (US \$ 100) is to be enclosed with the Complaint which otherwise shall not be accepted for any reason whatsoever. However, the fee is refundable only if the complaint is genuine.

Article (6) Subscription and Obligations the Local Federation organizing an International Tournament

Countries can have more than one team in an International Tournament but the result of only one team shall be considered especially in the games qualifying for the World's Championship. Any other participating teams shall be out of the Tournament.

The Host Local Federation of an International Tournament shall incur the prices of the Air Tickets, Accommodation and Allowances specified in the Financial with regard to Regulations of the International Referees and International Veterinary Doctors involved in the Tournament.

Article (7)

1. *Competitions Committee Regulations shall be applicable to the Tent Pegging Sport.*

2. *All matters not specified in these Regulations are subject to the Resolutions of the Board of Directors of the International Federation.*
